


**Q1 HB 1054: Raises smoking age to 21**  
**Raises the legal age to twenty-one years in order for the sale or distribution of tobacco and vapor products to be made.**







Establishes the Washington state life at conception act.**



aggravated first-degree murder.**





### Q7 HJM 4000: Dividing Washington state Petitions for the creation of a new state in eastern Washington.


