Dear Chairwoman Clibborn,

As House members representing Snohomish County, we are asking that you consider the projects below as part of the *Connecting Washington* Proposal. *The North Puget Sound Manufacturing Corridor* is vastly underrepresented in the current transportation revenue proposal. As a delegation, we have put together a list of projects that will stimulate job growth in the aerospace sector and in manufacturing, as well as improving job connectivity. Our delegation has worked closely with our communities, business, labor, and ports to create a group of transportation projects that will help move Snohomish County and Washington State into a strong economic recovery. Below is the list of priorities that we would like to be funded under any transportation revenue package this session:
