Title: "AN ACT Relating to protecting the privacy and security of internet users"

- Requires broadband internet providers to provide notice and obtain consent for access to, use, and disclosure of certain customer information, with specific exceptions.
- Requires broadband internet providers to provide notice of privacy policies and take reasonable data security measures.
- Subjects broadband internet providers to existing data breach notification requirements for certain customer information.
- Makes a violation of the act enforceable under the consumer protection act, 19.86 RCW, and creates an appropriated fund for administration and enforcement.
- Requires the Office of the Attorney General to submit a report to the Legislature by December 1, 2020 on additional opportunities for increasing consumer privacy transparency, control, and protection.
