WHAT COULD HAPPEN: Cuts to human services and early learning programs that eliminate and significantly reduce services provided to those in poverty and low-income households.

## -\$1.3 BILLION

The Book 1 budget reduces human services spending by \$1.3 billion over the next four years. Those cuts include:

- Reductions to TANF funding (-\$117 million)
- Reductions to the ABD Program (-\$91 million)
- Eliminates the TANF diaper subsidy
- Reductions in food security & assistance including senior nutrition, summer EBT and the fruit & vegetable incentive program (-\$204 million)
- And in ECEAP: reduces ECEAP slots, eliminates Early ECEAP (-\$263 million)
