WHAT COULD HAPPEN: Seniors, people with developmental disabilities, and those in need of long term care see massive reductions to services designed to ensure quality of life.

-\$1.5 BILLION

Under current law, the four year cuts to long term care and developmental disabilities programs and services reaches nearly \$1.5 billion through:

- Senior housing support & the Governor's Opportunity for Supportive Housing, a long-term care service for individuals transitioning to independent living with housing search and tenancy support (-\$190 million)
- Cap on personal care and residential services (-\$174 million)
- No rate increases for nursing homes, adult family homes, assisted living, and 46,000 independent providers and agencies (-\$937 million)
- No extra support for transferring clients to community settings
