- Day 1: January 8, 2024
- Policy Committee Cutoff: January 31, 2024
- Fiscal Committee Cutoff: February 5, 2024
- House of Origin Cutoff: February 13, 2024
- Policy Committee Cutoff – Opposite House: February 21, 2024
- Fiscal Committee Cutoff – Opposite House: February 26, 2024
- Opposite House Cutoff: March 1, 2024
- Day 60, Last Day of Session: March 7, 2024
